NOTICE TO ALL TENDERERS –

RENTAL OF CRANES

On the condition that the scope of this tender is limited to work which can be described as coming within the trade jurisdiction of the International Union of Operating Engineers, all tenderers should pay special attention to the following:

1. A collective agreement has been negotiated between The Electrical Power Systems Construction Association (EPSCA) and the International Union of Operating Engineers establishing rates of pay and working conditions for work in the Electrical Power Systems sector of the construction industry.
2. The International Union of Operating Engineers is bound by the terms and conditions of the EPSCA Collective Agreement. Contractors submitting tenders are required to base the field labour portion of their tendered prices on the terms and conditions of the EPSCA Collective Agreement. A copy of the EPSCA Collective Agreement can be obtained from the EPSCA website at www.epsca.ca.

ATTENTION – IMPORTANT

Notwithstanding anything set out above, work coming within the trade jurisdiction of the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 793 (**as that jurisdiction relates to Crane and Equipment Rentals**) shall not be subject to the provisions of the EPSCA Collective Agreement if the Employer of employees performing work within such jurisdiction is a **party to a collective agreement with the International Union of Operating Engineers local 793 with respect to Crane and Equipment Rentals**. In such a situation, the provisions of that collective agreement shall apply.
