

HAZARDOUS MATERIAL SPILL REPORTING

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT REQUIRES SPILL INCIDENTS INVOLVING FUELS, OIL, HYDRAULIC FLUID, HERBICIDES AND OTHER POLLUTANTS TO BE REPORTED FORTHWITH TO THE MINISTRY OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND TO THE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY WHERE THE SPILL OCCURRED.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM ALL ACTS REQUIRED OF THE OWNER OR CONTROLLER OF ANY SPILLED MATERIALS AND COMPLY WITH ALL PERTINENT LEGISLATION. INCIDENTS OF SPILLS SHALL BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY TO THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LEGISLATION.

ONTARIO POWER GENERATION INC.'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL ALSO BE NOTIFIED OF ALL SPILLS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SPILLS AND WILL BE LIABLE FOR ANY RESULTING PROPERTY DAMAGE, ANY COSTS INCURRED BY ONTARIO POWER GENERATION INC. FOR CONTAINMENT AND CLEAN UP OF THE SPILLED MATERIAL, AND ANY COSTS, LIABILITY OR PENALTIES INCURRED BY ONTARIO POWER GENERATION INC. DUE THE CONTRACTOR'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RELEVANT LEGISLATION.
