CNSC RENEWS LICENCE FOR PICKERING A
Three year term reflects harmonization of Pickering A and B licences

Durham – The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) has granted the Pickering A Nuclear station a renewal of its operating licence.

“We’re pleased that CNSC staff and commission members acknowledged the safe operation of Pickering A over the past five year licence period and have confidence in OPG’s ability to continue that safe operation,” said Glenn Jager, Station Vice President.

“We really appreciate the support we received from more than 30 community and industry interveners and will continue to earn their confidence with our focus on safety and transparency in operations,” he said.

He noted the three year term reflects the regulator’s intent to harmonize the licence terms for both Pickering A and Pickering B.

Operating licences for both Pickering Nuclear generating stations will expire on June 30, 2013.
