BRIEF MAINTENANCE OUTAGE FOR UNIT 8 AT PICKERING NUCLEAR

[Pickering, ON]: Ontario Power Generation took Unit 8 at Pickering Nuclear out of service today for a brief maintenance outage.

The outage will allow inspection and maintenance on a valve in the heat transport system. Prior to this outage unit 8 has operated consecutively at or close to 100 per cent for over 200 days.

Pickering B unit 5 recently returned from a brief outage caused by an algae run. Pickering units 6 and 7 are operating at or near full power. Pickering B is currently delivering about 1500 MW of electricity to the provincial grid and has produced over six billion kilowatt hours of electricity this year, or about eight per cent of the Province's electricity this year.
