ONTARIO POWER GENERATION EXTENDS ITS OUTREACH ON NEW BUILD NUCLEAR WITH COMMUNITY KIOSK

[Durham]: On Tuesday, May 20, 2008, Ontario Power Generation (OPG) extended its community outreach on the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Darlington B Nuclear New Build project with the opening of its information kiosk in the conveniently located Bowmanville Mall.

“OPG is reaching out to hear what the community has to say about the potential for new nuclear units at our Darlington site, and to ensure the community’s input is included in EA studies,” said OPG’s Pat McNeil, Senior Vice President Nuclear Generation Development, at Tuesday’s opening event.

“This information kiosk will provide the community with a convenient place to discover what’s happening on the Darlington B nuclear project, ask questions, provide input and get more information,” added McNeil. “There are things for people of all ages to explore on the project.”

The federal environmental assessment (EA) on new nuclear at Darlington B is well underway; OPG has been collecting baseline environmental studies, assessing site layout options and is now in its third round (of five) consultations.

OPG’s Community Kiosk is open to the public Tuesday through Saturday.
