## ONTARIO POWER GENERATION'S DARLINGTON UNIT 2 ENTERS PLANNED OUTAGE

[Clarington, ON]: Today Darlington's Unit 2 was taken off line for its planned maintenance outage.

This outage will include major work on the turbine generator, feeder pipe replacement, pump refurbishment and numerous safety inspections of reactor systems.

Darlington's Unit 2 has been performing well over the past year, having operated safely and reliably for 362 consecutive days. The unit's nuclear performance is currently ranked number one in the world amongst CANDU style reactors for both safety and electrical generation.

Darlington's other Units (1, 3, and 4) are currently operating at 100 per cent full power delivering over 2500 MW of electricity to the Ontario electricity grid.
