## DURING THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2009

- Pickering B's capability factor for the first six months of 2009 was 83.17 per cent compared to 71.91 for the same period last year.
- In support of biodiversity in the community, OPG "Green Team" employee volunteers participated in a tree planting in Alex Robertson Park. OPG and community partners have planted more than 6,000 trees in Alex Robertson Park since 2004.
- Pickering B bettered the Canadian Electricity Association Accident Severity Rate and All Injury Rate top quartile threshold, a benchmark standard for the electricity industry.
