

Earth Week Tree Planting


Sunday April 27

- Darlington Nuclear partnered with Central Lakes Ontario Conservation Authority (CLOCA) to provide a community tree planting
- 500 native Eastern White Cedar seedlings were planted in the Bowmanville Westside Conservation Area
- Since 2000 OPG has worked with partners to plant more than 8 million native trees and shrubs across Ontario.



Courtice Secondary School

- OPG works with community partners to support regional ecosystems and biodiversity through science-based habitat stewardship
- April 5: Site nest box maintenance
- April 26: Earth Week garbage cleanup & Millenium Trail maintenance
- May 21: Pollinator workshop and planting activity



Bring Back the Salmon

- Five-month hands-on educational partnership
- Introduces students, and teachers to the Atlantic Salmon species, their history in Ontario, and the restoration efforts to bring back a healthy and self-sustaining population to Lake Ontario.
